

THIRD ACTIVITY OF THE PROJECT INTERACTIVE WEBINAR SESSIONS

The interactive webinars, led by İnovasyon Girişimcilik Eğitim ve Araştırma Derneği (Turkey) with partners Sustainable Development Studies Network (Belgium) and Smart Agro Hub (Greece), will run from August to September 2024.

These sessions aim to boost the digital literacy and precision agricultural skills of VET trainers and educators as the project focuses on integrating Precision Agriculture (PA) technologies into farming, promoting sustainable and productive methods.

AIM OF THE WEBINARS

Activity 3 aims to provide comprehensive training in precision agriculture through six key topics, including digital approaches in agriculture, precision farming techniques, and EU initiatives.

The main goal is to enhance VET trainers' understanding of PA, promote digital tool adoption in agriculture, and support EU sustainability policies. Conducted via Zoom, the webinars will feature expert trainers and interactive sessions to ensure effective learning.

PARTICIPANTS PROFILE AND ORGANIZATION

The webinars will include 45 participants (15 from each partner country), selected from VET trainers, agricultural staff, and local municipality counselors.

Participants will be chosen through a fair process, with announcements on social media and CV submissions.

The sessions will include interactive presentations and electronic assessments, fostering a collaborative learning environment to drive agricultural digital transformation in their regions.
